

Directions to Warminster “IR 2” Gallery Range.

These directions should be read in conjunction with viewing the Map / Google Earth Sat. view etc. and your own Road Map/s.

Warminster, in the County of Wiltshire, is situated on the west side of Salisbury Plain, due South of the M4 Motorway.

1) Approaching from the North (Also West & East):-

a) From Junction **17 of M4**, take **A350 south**, passing by / through – Chippenham, Melksham, Trowbridge and Westbury.

b) Approx half way between Westbury & Warminster (Still on A 350) you will pass through / by the village of **Upton Scudamore**.

Continue a short distance and take the first left into Westbury Road. This becomes Copheap Lane for a short distance, before terminating at a “T” junction.

c) Turn left at this junction into Imber Road and continue on to Land Warfare Centre and Warminster Training Centre, situated on you left hand side, just past a Church also on the left. Turn left and park up on left just before Gate House & report to security. They will direct you to the Range, which is on the North end of the Camp.

Park in the Car Park adjacent to the 800/900 m part of the range. (See google earth) And await further info.

2) Approaching from West :-

a) Via A 36, A 362 heading in to Warminster, follow signs for Hospital (On Left) then pass Railway at right angles. In just a short distance you should reach the Junction of Copheap Lane & Imber Road.

b) Now follow directions as at **1c)** above.

3) Approaching from South :-

a) Via A 350, A 36 – Head into Warminster & follow signs & directions as above at **2) & 1c)**

Remember to have your ID Badge with you and PLEASE let me know if you are going to be present on the day, as the club have to notify security of attendee's and car registrations at least 2 days ahead. This is the same as at Lydd.

Don't forget, IR2 Range is a gallery range up to 900 m.(6 Firing Points). FCSA will be using it for long range shooting. Therefore you should be using calibre's, Ammo & equipment capable of 900 m. Max ME is 7000 J, any over 4500 J will have to do HME test at 200 m. **NO Tracer** is allowed.
